How Sermorelin Works in the Body

Sermorelin works by mimicking the action of GHRH and by binding to receptors in the brain that trigger the release of growth hormone. It is important to note that sermorelin is not a growth hormone itself, but rather it stimulates the body's own growth hormone production.

When injected into the body, it causes the release of growth hormone from the pituitary gland. Sermorelin injections help to counteract decreases in muscle mass and bone density by stimulating the body's natural production of growth hormone.

Sermorelin comes in injection or pill format.
